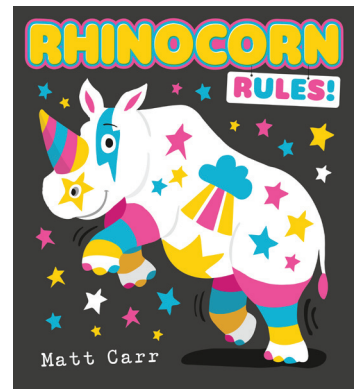


Create your own Rhinocorn Kite!



YOU WILL NEED:

- A3 sheet of coloured paper
- A ball of string
- Glue/sellotape
- 5 paper straws (two for the width, three for the length)
- Scissors
- Ribbon



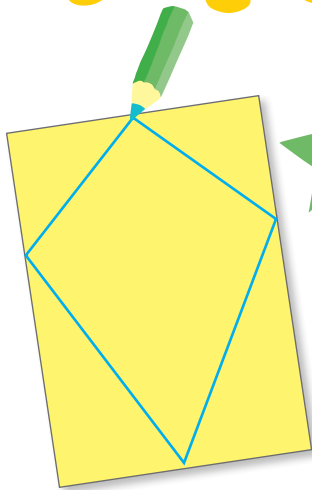
Print out the rhinocorn outline and shapes, then cut them out. Please ask an adult to do this for you. Using the glue, decorate your rhinocorn with the shapes you love the most!

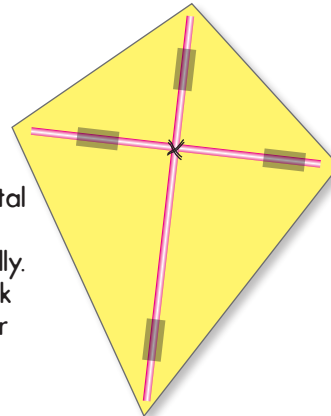
Using the diamond shape as a guide, draw a kite onto the A3 sheet of paper and cut out.



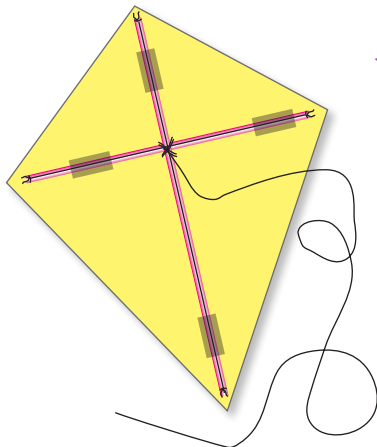
Stick your colourful rhinocorn on the front side of the kite using more glue.



To make the straw supports, cross them together so that the horizontal ones sit at the widest point. Then repeat this step to support vertically. Sellotape the straws onto the back of your kite, and tie them together at the centre with string.



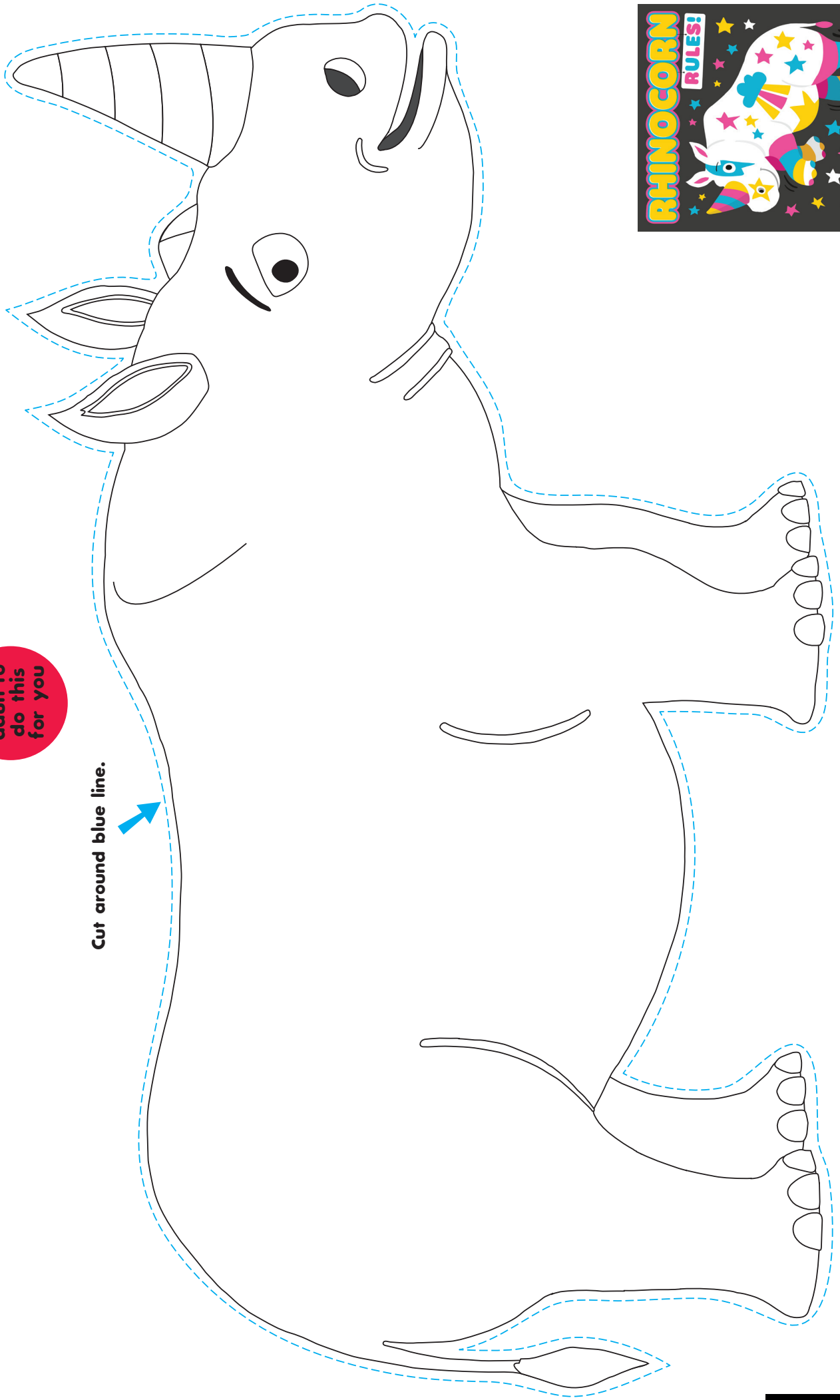
Cut a length of string to match the length of vertical support – that's the longest straw support. Tie each end to the edge of the straw. Repeat with the horizontal support straws. Then cut a new piece of very long string and tie it in the middle of the straws for you to hold on to.



Add ribbons to make a colourful tail.



Go and fly your kite!
